The Adult, Infant, and Child CPR/AED/First Aid online course will prepare students to recognize and care for emergencies. The course features award-winning simulation learning an interactive experience where students will respond to real-world emergencies in a virtual setting to help prepare you to recognize and respond to a variety of first aid, breathing and cardiac emergencies involving adults, children and infants. Students who complete this course will meet one of the requirements of working in an early childhood center setting or healthcare facility.

This course does not meet OSHA requirements for workplace certification. Many workplaces require training delivered by an instructor to meet OSHA requirements and do not accept certificates of completion from an online-only course. If you are seeking a certificate that meets OSHA requirements, enroll in our Adult and Pediatric First Aid/CPR/AED Blended Learning Course or Instructor-Led Training Course.
