

ETA Electronics Module 1 DC

Aligned Program of Study: Mechanical, Electrical, and Plumbing Systems (MEP)

Description

The Electronics Modules program is based on ETA's Associate level certification, and is divided into five modules; however, only the first module is required for the student to earn this certification. The purpose of this module series is to align with a growing portion of the electronics education industry that is charged with providing electronics training that does not include the total content of traditional basic electronics courses.

This assessment is offered via two different pathways: stand-alone and journeyman. The stand-alone pathway is for students that do not wish to complete a career track. The journeyman pathway allows for stackable certification tracks and is offered in five parts.

Exam Details

There are no requirements before taking a test. This certification is valid for a lifetime and is offered online or via paper/pencil. A site administrator and proctor must be selected. This certification allows for remote proctoring for an additional fee of \$14 for the two-hour exam. ETA allows for one free retake after a 30-day waiting period and must be completed within one year of the first exam. Students can take a free practice exam at
