This letter is to request that a "Certificate of Exemption" be issued by the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Board to the Metro Public Health Department, Pollution Control Division for the period of July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2024 in accordance with the provisions of the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Board Act, Section 68-201-115(a).
