

HAZARDOUS WASTE CONTAINER STORAGE PERMIT ISSUED TO CLEAN HARBORS TENNESSEE, LLC

The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC) Division of Solid Waste Management (DSWM) has issued a hazardous waste storage permit to Clean Harbors Tennessee, LLC (Clean Harbors) for the Hazardous Waste Storage Facility in Greenbrier, Tennessee. The facility (EPA ID TND000645770) is located in Robertson County at 2815 Old Greenbrier Pike, Greenbrier, Tennessee 37073. This decision follows a 45-day public comment period on the draft permit that ended on September 6, 2024. A [Response to Comments](#) has been issued to identify minor changes made to finalize the permit. No comments were received from the public and no hearing was requested. One comment was received from Clean Harbors requesting the removal of Section II Subsection T Prohibition of the Placement of Transfer Hazardous Waste in Permitted Storage Units from the permit. DSWM denied the request to remove Section II Subsection T.

The renewal permit (TNHW-196, formerly TNHW-144) allows Clean Harbors to continue to store hazardous waste with a total maximum capacity of 200,000 gallons of hazardous waste in four units, including providing site security, conducting daily, weekly, and monthly inspections of the site, maintaining records on site, and submitting an Annual Report in accordance with the Permit. Clean Harbors will provide notification of any newly discovered release to the environment and maintain financial assurance with the DSWM.

The permit is issued under the authority of the Tennessee Hazardous Waste Management Act of 1977, as amended, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 68-212-101 et seq., and Rule Chapter 0400-12-01, Hazardous Waste Management. The permit is effective as of September 27, 2024, and shall remain in effect until September 27, 2034, unless continued, revoked and issued, or terminated under applicable regulations.
