

**NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF TERMINATION REQUEST FOR
HAZARDOUS WASTE FACILITY PERMIT TNHW-152
MILAN ARMY AMMUNITION PLANT**

The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC) Division of Solid Waste Management (DSWM) received a hazardous waste management permit termination request from Milan Army Ammunition Plant (MLAAP) for the termination of RCRA permit (TNHW-152) on August 20, 2024. This facility (EPA ID TN0210020582) is located in Gibson County at 2280 Highway 104 West, Milan, Tennessee 38358 (see map).

The permit, TNHW-152, was issued on September 26, 2012, and was effective for ten years. On March 8, 2021, the DSWM sent MLAAP a Permit Renewal Call Letter to remind MLAAP of the permit expiration date and to remind MLAAP to submit (within 180 calendar days prior to permit expiration) a Part A and Part B permit application including application fees for the renewal of their permit. MLAAP subsequently sent to the DSWM a Notice of Intent to Close on August 4, 2021. The Notice of Intent to Close was submitted within the 180-calendar day timeframe and thus allowed continued operations related to closure of the facility under the existing permit.

As set forth in the Regulations, a complete permit application, consisting of a Part A and a Part B, must include certain text, drawings, and other information adequate to demonstrate that the facility complied with the various technical and administrative standards applicable for closure to such a facility. Evaluation of the termination request involves an in-depth review of the termination materials by DSWM staff and subsequent correspondence between DSWM and the facility identifying and correcting any deficiencies in the submitted information.

Once the termination request is determined to be complete, the DSWM will make a tentative decision to terminate the permit. Public Notice will be given of this tentative decision, and the public will have at least 45 days to submit written comments on the draft terminated permit/proposed action. A public hearing, if requested, may also be held to receive public comments within this public comment period. After considering the public comments received and making any appropriate revisions, the DSWM director will issue a final permit decision to terminate the existing permit. A Response to Comments will also be issued at that time.
