Any restatement of ITB text in the Question/Comment column shall NOT be construed as a change in the actual wording of the documents.

1. Are contractual terms negotiable?	No
2. Is the target delivery date negotiable? Will proposals that are unable to meet the target delivery date be acceptable?	No
3. What is the scoring rubric for the bid?	The awarded bidder will be respondent whose response meets the requirements and criteria set forth in this ITB at the lowest cost.
4. Is there a preference for a gas or diesel chassis?	Yes, we are now changing the specification to require a diesel engine. Please refer to bullet #2 in Specifications Section "Vehicle Type."
5. Will a vehicle shorter than 30' be acceptable?	No
6. Should the awning be electric?	No preference
7. What level of graphics package should be included? Half-wrap, full-wrap, other?	A partial wrap should be included. The wrap will cover approximately 75% of the vehicle.
8. How many scene lights should be included? Location(s) of scene lights? Passenger side only?	At least two scene lights on both the driver and passenger sides of the vehicle. Please refer to bullet# 3 in Specifications Section "Exterior Features."
9. Only a backup camera is requested. Should side-view cameras be included?	No preference.
10. What is preferred make/model and/or functionality of the exam table? Is the Mdmrk 224-002 model acceptable?	Preferred model is the Ritter 204, however, similar/equivalent make/model is acceptable.
11. Will a layout to include exam room w/ wheelchair access, lab with medical grade	No, we are requesting two exam rooms.

refrigeration, an intake/reception area, and a bathroom be accepted in lieu of the requested?	
12. Please define the correct addresses for delivery and training. The delivery address is listed in Nashville, TN and the training address is listed in Knoxville, TN.	Delivery will be at 6500 Centennial Blvd., Nashville, TN 37243 and the training will be conducted at 2101 Medical Center Way, Knoxville, TN.
13. What areas of the unit are needed to be ADA accessible?	The exam room with the ADA lift is the only area of the vehicle that must be ADA accessible.
14. Section 3.22 of the Terms and Conditions of the above-referenced bid requires that "Respondents shall be properly licensed as of the date it files a response to this ITB and shall provide evidence of compliance with all applicable provisions of the Contractors Licensing Act of 1994..." the proposed Respondent, is a out of state-licensed motor vehicle dealer and has no physical location or employees in the state of Tennessee. A review of the state's licensing websites does not show any activities that would be undertaken by the proposed Respondent that appear to require any type of Contractor License.	This is a standard T&C and is not applicable to this procurement.
15. Can you advise on what all areas of the medical unit need to be ADA accessible?	The exam room with the ADA lift is the only area of the vehicle that must be ADA accessible.
16. Besides the driver and passenger, are there any other approved riding position seats required for staff members?	No
17. Reception area: Besides seating position at a desk for the staff member and the person they are processing, How many waiting area seats do you require?	We would like to have 1-2 waiting area seats if the design allows.
18. Due to the short time between receiving answers to the questions and the bid submission can you extend the bid date a week or so?	Yes.
19. You are asking for gas or diesel, will you accept a gas chassis with an option for diesel? Will you accept additional options to consider with our bid response?	We are now changing the minimum requirement to be a diesel engine. Please refer to bullet #2 in Specifications Section "Vehicle Type."
20. It is customary for a manufacturer to require a deposit and progress or COD payment upon acceptance. Is this acceptable?	Payment will be sent only once the vehicle is received and is verified to be in good order. The State will pay the invoice with Net 30 terms.

"At least one of the examination tables shall be the standard size of 16.875"L x 19.5"W x 7.75"H" Please clarify.</p>	<p>The exam table dimensions listed in the specifications were incorrect. Dimensions should be approximately 46.6" (L) x 20.5" (W) x 33.13" (H) These dimensions are for the Ritter 204. We will accept this model or equivalent. Please refer to bullet# 3 in Specifications Section "Interior Layout and Equipment."</p>
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3. **Delete ITB 32101-13013 Specifications in its entirety and replace it with 32101-13013 Specifications V2.** Revisions of the original specifications document are emphasized within the new release. **Any sentence or paragraph containing revised or new text is highlighted.**
