

TENNESSEE STATE FIRE MARSHAL'S OFFICE SMOKE ALARM SPECIFICATIONS

A. SCOPE:

A.1. The Contractor shall provide all goods and deliverables as required, described, and detailed below.

A.2. Contractor shall deliver residential smoke alarms meeting the following requirements, upon receipt of an approved purchase order, to the specified location.

a. Kidde i9010 Ionization Smoke Alarm with a 10-year sealed battery, contractor pack model 21029885 or newer

1. Alarm must have a sealed, on-board battery, that cannot be removed by the homeowner.
2. Alarm must include all necessary installation hardware, standard user instructions, and warranty information.
3. Alarm must be packaged in contractor soft pack easy open boxes, without plastic, clamshell, or blister packaging, 6 per case - 3 alarms per carton, 2 cartons per case, and be ready for immediate installation.

A.3. Contractor shall deliver the requested quantity, using a lift-gate, to a Department of Commerce and Insurance location in either Davidson or Bedford County. The primary shipping address will be:
