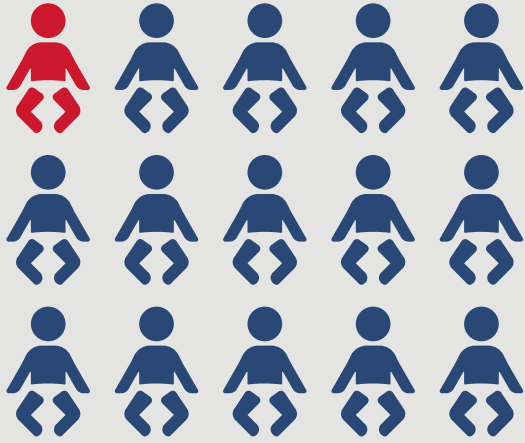


COVID-19 and Pregnancy in Tennessee



Among all infants born to Tennessee residents from March 1, 2020 to February 28, 2022, **10,895 (7%)** had evidence of maternal COVID-19 in pregnancy



ICU admissions at delivery were **5x** as high among women with COVID-19 in pregnancy as those without (**0.5% vs. 0.1%**)



There have been **19 confirmed maternal deaths** due to COVID-19 in pregnancy through February 28, 2022



Among confirmed maternal deaths, **89% (17/19)** had no documentation of COVID-19 vaccination

The CDC recommends COVID-19 vaccination for all people 12 years and older, including those who are pregnant, breastfeeding, trying to get pregnant now, or might become pregnant in the future



The COVID-19 vaccine is safe and effective in pregnancy



The COVID-19 vaccine is **NOT** associated with decreased fertility



The COVID-19 vaccine is **NOT** associated with higher miscarriage rates



The COVID-19 vaccine can **NOT** give you COVID-19 or alter your DNA
