

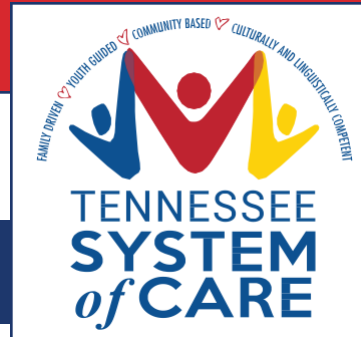
# Children & Youth Service Providers
