They are a statewide, immigrant, and refugee-led collaboration. They organize both individuals, as well as organizations that serve immigrant and refugee communities.

Their mission is to build power, amplify our voices, and organize communities to advocate for our rights. Their vision is a stronger, more inclusive Tennessee where people of all nationalities, immigration statuses, and racial identities can belong and thrive. They are nationally recognized for their multiethnic, multigenerational coalition building, effective legislative advocacy, and award-winning communications initiatives.

While TIRRC is advocacy-centered, they also offer services such as English classes, citizenship classes, legal services, and a resource referral line.
