

# Vaccine Data Updates (as of 7/19/21 1900)

## 5,458,892 doses administered<sup>1</sup>

- Tennesseans with at least one dose
  - **2,934,379 or 43%** (up from 42.5%)
  - Compared with National rate = **56.1%** (up from **55.5%**)<sup>2</sup>
- Tennesseans fully immunized
  - **2,628,089 or 38.5%** (up from 38%)
  - Compared with National rate = **48.6%** (up from **48%**)<sup>2</sup>

**↑62K COVID-19 vaccine doses administered in the last 7d<sup>1</sup>**

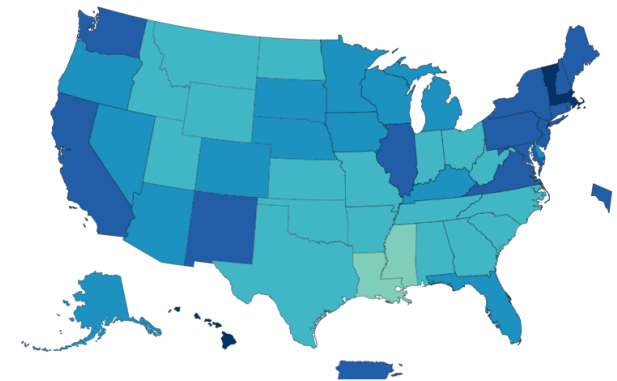

# Tennessee Ranking <sup>3</sup>

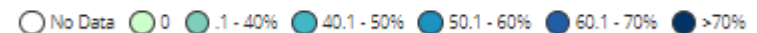
- **43<sup>rd</sup>** for vaccine administration/100K population
  - Ahead of GA, MS, AL, LA, WY, AR, ID
- **45<sup>th</sup>** for % of total population with at least one dose
  - Ahead of MS, AL, LA, WY, ID,
- **43<sup>rd</sup>** for % of total population fully vaccinated
  - Ahead of GA, MS, AL, LA, WY, AR, ID

Percent of People Receiving at Least One Dose Reported to the CDC by State/Territory and for Select Federal Entities for the Total Population



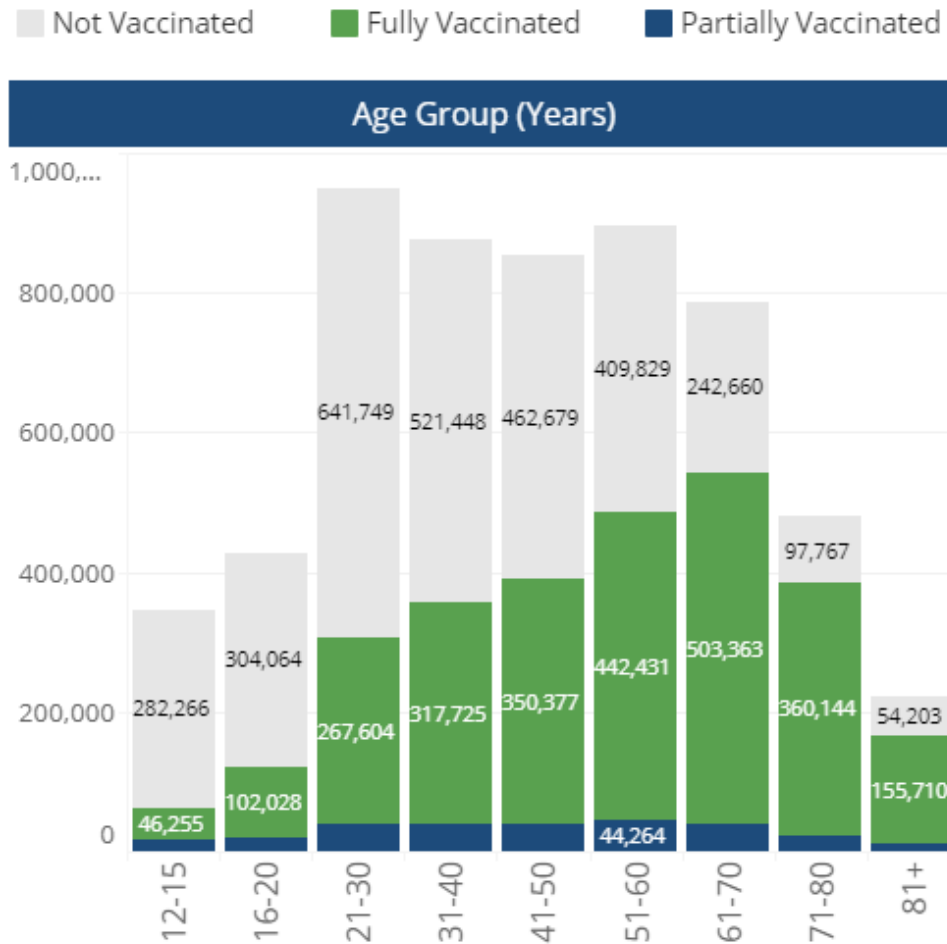
% Population with >1 dose
