Revocation – Automatic, Permanent

The Background:

Facts: On February 9, 2018, Educator was convicted of two (2) counts of especially aggravated sexual exploitation of a minor and one (1) count of sexual exploitation of a minor involving over 100 images. Educator had recorded over forty (40) elementary-aged student undressing over the course of four (4) years. Educator was sentenced to a cumulative twenty-four (24) years in prison to be served at 100% and is on the sex offender registry. Pursuant to Board Rule 0520-02-03-.09(4)(a) and T.C.A. § 49-5-413(d)(3)(B)(i), Educator's license is subject to automatic revocation.

Status: Respondent was notified by certified mail of the Board's intent to revoke his educator license based upon these findings. Respondent received said notice.

The Recommendation:

Respondent's conduct constitutes grounds for license revocation pursuant to Rule 0520-02-03-.09(3)(a), (3)(g), and (4)(a).

The Board staff recommends the automatic, permanent revocation of Respondent's Tennessee educator license.
