

Certificate of Liability Insurance

FOR PROFESSIONAL LIABILITY
AGAINST OMISSIONS AND ERRORS

Instructions

1. The consultant's insurance company shall submit one certificate per basic agreement.
2. The certificate must state that coverage is for "professional liability" or "omissions and errors".
3. The certificate must explicitly stipulate the amount per claim/occurrence and the amount per annual aggregate.
4. The State's agreement number shall be included in the description field of the certificate.
5. The consultant is responsible for maintaining coverage and making sure the insurance company submits a new certificate when the current one expires.
6. The certificate must be submitted by your insurance company to the civil engineering director of TDOT's Roadway Design Division before work commences.
