Further, if the Department of Transportation shall award a Contract to the Respondent, the Respondent shall, within the timeline prescribed in the Request for Proposals, after it receives written notice of the award, fully execute a Contract on the basis of the terms, conditions and prices set forth in its Response and provide a bond with good and sufficient surety, as required for the faithful performance of the Contract and for the protection of all persons supplying labor, material, and equipment for the prosecution of the work, as detailed in the Request for Proposals. In the event the Respondent withdraws its Response after the Notice of Intent to Award, or after award of the Contract has been made fails to execute such the Contract and/or such additional documents as may be required and to provide the required bond within the time period specified above, then the Department of Transportation shall cash the attached check and retain the funds, not as a penalty, but as agreed upon liquidated damages.

NOW, THEREFORE, the condition of this obligation is: the Principal shall not withdraw its Proposal within sixty (60) days after Notice of Intent to Award, or within such other time period as may be provided in the Request for Proposals, and if the Department of Transportation shall award a Contract to the Principal, the Principal shall, within ten (10) days after written notice of the award is received by him, fully execute a Contract on the basis of the terms, conditions and unit prices set forth in his Proposal or bid and provide a bond with good and sufficient surety, as required for the faithful performance of the Contract and for the protection of all persons supplying labor, material, and equipment for the prosecution of the work. In the event the Principal withdraws its bid after the Notice of Intent to Award, or after award of the Contract has been made fails to execute such the Contract and/or such additional documents as may be required and to provide the required bond within the time period specified above, then the amount of this Bid Bond shall be immediately paid to the Department of Transportation, not as a penalty, but as agreed upon liquidated damages.
